

## Slips, Trips, and Falls

- Keep walking surfaces clear of debris, electrical cords, tools, and other equipment.
- Make sure that floors are kept clean and dry and that they are not slippery.
- Always clean up spills immediately and provide warning signs for wet floor areas.
- Use no-skid waxes and surfaces coated with grit to create non-slip surfaces.
- Eliminate uneven walking surfaces and mark any changes in walking levels with yellow strips or another appropriate identification measure.
- Keep stairways and hallways free from clutter and ensure that all areas are well lit.
- Ensure that snow and ice removal is done promptly and frequently, and that slippery surfaces are treated with sand and/or salt.
- Wear shoes with good support and slip-resistant soles.
- Always use the handrail when walking up or down stairways.
- Inspect walking surfaces frequently to identify and correct any fall hazards.
